Key to success is making dreams come true

Respected Mataji is an icon of Women Empowerment, from an era, when Indian women in conservative family environment were not allowed to move outdoors, leave alone getting educated, or work for betterment of the society. Born in a dignified business family in Lahore on may 29, 1922, to blessed parents Smt. Chawli vati & Shri Nanuram. Her Grandfather Lala Amin Chand was the doyen of famous business group- Amichand Pyarelal. Today the elder family generation is represented by well known – Lord Swaraj Paul.

Educating the girl child was given equal emphaiss in the family, as that for the male siblings. Mata ji turned out to be very good student throughout and 'did very well for herself. She was one of the First women in Punjab to achieve the degree of "Bachelor of Teaching" followed by Post Graduate Degree.

Mata ji worked for Punjab Education Services till she retired as Principal – Govt. Girls Higher Secondary Schools, in the year 1980. Her mission throughout was to encourage the girl child and the rural poor to get educated. She enshrined the quality of discipline, dedication and continuous quest for knowledge amongst her numerous students.

Mata Ji married Shri Mohinder Singh Syngle, a legal luminary, from a very illustrious family, son of Sardar Lala Nathu Lal Ji Syngle , the Nazam (Collector) of the erstwhile State of Jind. She is blessed with Two Sons and a daughter Manish, Manoj & Monica. Manish & Monica are settled in USA, in short Malti Ji is a compact Personality endowed with Love – Compassion & Spirit.

Mata Ji did not take rest after her formal retirement. She continues to lead an active life as an educaniost, and as a social worker. What ever she does – she accomplishes it with intricacy of details, human touch and affection. Besides being deeply religious and spiritual person.

With passion for education – she along with her worthy son Manoj, promoted M and M Education Campus, in economically under developed district Sangrur in Punjab, the land of her forefathers, for benefit of rural poor students. The Complex consists of an English medium higher secondary school, a teachers training college, and some more institutes in the pipeline, on this 22 acre campus.

The Rt Hon Lord Paul of Marylebone, PC, Chairman of Caparo Group, is a leading businessman and member of the House of Lords, where he was Deputy Speaker for the period December 2008 - November 2010. Lord Paul was appointed to the Privy Council in 2009.

Lord Paul's roots are from an illustrious family of Punjab, having pedigree & business history of over 300 years. Born in Jalandhar, India in 1931.

Educated at Punjab University and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, USA; achieved M.Sc. in Mechanical Engineering degree, six decades ago. He describes MIT as an outstanding University with splendid student facilities. He continues to maintain a relationship with MIT.

Lord Paul joined the family business founded by his father in India, Apeejay Surrendra Group, in 1952. Married to Aruna Vij in 1956. Blessed with three sons and one daughter, (one daughter deceased).

Lord Paul was member of the London Development Agency from 2000-2008 and from 2005-2008 infrastructure for the London 2012 Olympic Games on time and on budget. He was also on the board of London 2012 and a member of the British Olympic Association Advisory Board.

Lord Paul has been Co-Chairman of the India-UK Round Table, an India-UK joint government initiative, from 2000-2005. He has led Parliamentary delegations to India and other parts of the world with the Commonwealth Parliamentary Association and the Inter-Parliamentary Union. He was an Ambassador for British Business, a UK government initiative, from 1997 to 2005 representing UK trade and investment on 75 occasions in 30 different countries.

Lord Paul was honored with appointment as Chancellor of the University of Wolverhampton in 1999 and Chancellor of the University of Westminster in 2006.

The Government of India bestowed the honor of Padma Bhushan on Lord Swraj Paul in 1983. He was granted the "Freedom of the City of London" in 1998.

Lord Paul believes and practices : "Always aspire for excellence, nothing else is good enough. Never abandon hope. Success will happen, as long as you work hard and with integrity."

Note: It may not be out of place to mention that Lala Pyarelal Ji (father of Lord Swraj Paul) and Lala Nanuram Ji (father of our respected Mata Ji Smt. Malti Syngle – having maiden name of Dhan Aggarwal) were brothers. All the siblings enjoyed their childhood happily together in joint family and imbibed values of rich culture, love and affection. They never addressed each other as cousins, but, always as brothers and sisters.

The theme of the Conference - PEACE AND DEVELOPMENT - A PUBLIC HEALTH PERSPECTIVE, is absolutely appropriate, keeping in view socio - economic - political scenario, prevailing all over the world.

I have been keenly observing for last few years, the dedicated mission being carried forward by your organization, for PEACE & DEVELOPMENT. I take this opportunity to express my deep appreciation & congratulations to very revered - Dr. L. S. Chawla and his dedicated team of senior doctors & colleagues, doing commendable work at IDPD, for benefit of the humanity.

"The IMPORTANCE OF PEACE FOR INDUSTRIAL & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT" is a subject close to my heart, being a first generation entrepreneur. I have been contributing my humble bit, for last three decades, towards industrial and economic growth, by generating employment from manufacturing activities & adding to government revenues, by paying various taxes.

Whole world is in turmoil today, due to conflicts between various countries, global terrorism, drug trafficking, the menace of HIV AIDS, population explosion in developing countries, global economic recession leading to mass scale unemployment- consequently unabated spurt in crime of all kinds, conflicts & tension, everywhere.

After World War II-which resulted in the worst atomic tragedy of Hiroshima & Nagasaki; the recent world history has taught us of several global conflicts, lasting for decades, having cascading effect towards economic destruction & disaster to humanity.

To name a few : Vietnam conflict, split of Korea in to North & South, Russian occupation of Afghanistan - now under monitoring of NATO forces. The ongoing civil strife in Syria and Egypt, Taliban ruling the roost in Pakistan. The "Gaza strip" story between Israel and Palestine. Tension between Iran & USA-consequent threat of Iran to let loose atomic weaponry- is looming large on humanity and world economy. Long term intervention of U.S. in Iraq resulted in destruction of Iraq & large scale human misery in that country. Besides, very badly crippling U.S. economy, to an extent that it has hardly shown any signs of revival in last few years.

U.S./Iraq situation, combined with other factors jeopardizing global peace, resulted in grave negative effect on world economy. At the same time, United Nations have failed to create a peaceful world.

To quote IDPD figures-World spends over US\$4.5 billion on Arms race, per day. Simultaneously, 15 thousand children die of hunger, everyday in the world. To quote UN statistics in simpler terms- world spends INR5/-per person on healthcare, for over 6.5 billion people, per annum. In the same ratio- INR 30 are spend on so called "defense" i.e. six times the amount spent on healthcare, for buying Arms and Ammunition.

All these combined negative factors, slowed down economic growth globally and India being no exception.

Impact of terrorism on India, especially in the states of Punjab and J & K, retarded economic growth. I may mention that on an average Indian budgetary allocation for Defense is 14%, as against 2% for Health and 3% for Education.

Having talked of current scenario in the world, leading to lack luster economic growth, I would now I like to share my thoughts with you on how to bring in PEACE & ECONOMIC PROSPERITY.

The Oxford dictionary meaning of PEACE is " State of being calm or quite."

"State of living in friendship."

"Situation or a period of time, in which there is no war or violence in a country."

Imagine a human being incharge of atomic arsenal, presses the "go ahead" button in a "negative state of mind" and its result!!!

Peace starts from human mind. We often define it as "peace of mind". In other words the person is defined as "cool". If human mind is peaceful, it has reflection on the values of his or her children, or over all environment in the family or home, at the workplace, the society and so on.

To bring in peace & prosperity, the human mind has to be open for learning & change; as well as the mind has to be emotionally intelligent. One of the elements of emotional intelligence is the ability to "know & manage emotions-one's own & that of others". If one appreciates others emotions, there would be no conflicts. If there are no conflicts, the path of peace and economic progress would be smooth. Peace is not unity in similarity but unity in diversity, in the conciliation of differences. Infact, I remember my first lesson in school on good behavior & good manners, which improves sensitive awareness of feelings of others.

Sri Ravi Shankar, the Art of Living Guru, has very rightly said:

"Globalize wisdom for better understanding & world peace. The 3C's : COMMUNILISM - CORRUPTION -CONFLICTS are choking the society & economic prosperity-secularize religion for prosperity & peace".

A cool human mind, spiritual approach & meditation, love and appreciation for others, good neighborly relations, quest for knowledge and sharing knowledge, would result in a healthy positive mind. Healthy positive mind would lead to peace & progress. I believe there are 3 broad principles for establishing healthy & robust relationships leading to peace & development in any home, organization, states or nation-namely; Trust, Communication and to understand the other person's perspective.

Having laid highest emphasis on a positive human mind for peace, I feel the concept of "Inclusive Growth" is essential for healthy and progressive economic development.

'Inclusive Growth, GDP & Human Development Index (HDI) are often talked and discussed. These should not be mere fashion or statistical statements. Economic growth of all combinations should be in reality "Inclusive", having direct impact on improvement in the quality of life of the common human being.

I believe that "Inclusive Growth" should be a combination of: integrated Infrastructure development, which results in providing Food, Water, Clothing, Housing, Sanitation& Hygiene facilities, Healthcare, Safety & Security of life, Education, Electricity, Public Transport network of roads - for all. Environment & Heritage Protection, Energy Conservation and extensive usage of non conventional energy like Solar system, Progressive Industrial Development generating employment, for Youth. Mass scale facilities for Research & Innovations. Narrowing of gap between Agriculture & Industrial growth, Arresting migration from Rural to Urban Areas". Inequities of growth can lead to social unrest which eventually would disrupt peace and development. We should always remember the history, otherwise we would be condemned to repeat it.

The impact of present massive investments in infrastructure gets diluted due to population explosion. Development is not keeping pace with population growth. If benefits of development have to reach Indian common citizen, population must be controlled at 1.25 billion. "Population Control" should be treated as an emergency element of "Inclusive Growth".

Finally, I would like to sum up in the words of Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam, His Excellency, the former President of India

"WHEN THERE IS RIGHTEOUSNESS IN THE HEART
THERE IS BEAUTY IN THE CHARACTER
WHEN THERE IS BEAUTY IN THE CHARACTER,
THERE IS HARMONY IN HOME
WHEN THERE IS HARMONY IN HOME,
THERE IS ORDER IN THE NATION
WHEN THERE IS ORDER IN THE NATION,
THERE IS PEACE IN THE WORLD"

Business is people; business is money; and time is money. Again, for any business, there are also diverse stake-holders, such as the Shareholders, Employees, Sellers from whom the business buys, Buyers to whom the business sells, Market segment to which the business caters and Society which the business serves.
